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

► B.Sc. NURSING

B.Sc. Nursing Programme

- The B.Sc Nursing programme is a four year full time programme comprising eight semester including internship which prepares B.Sc Nursing graduates qualified to practice nursing and midwifery in a variety of health care setting nationally and internationally.
- The programme is focused on developing critical care and thinking, skill proficiency and values necessary for the practice of professional nursing and midwifery. It prepares student to become responsible professionals by following code of moral values and fulfilling personal, social & professional responsibilities.
- Students are provided with opportunities to learn a whole range of skills, training and values in addition to acquiring knowledge related to nursing practice and profession.
- The whole curriculum is based and prepared according to the syllabus and guidelines given by INC, Delhi. The faculties involved are well qualified and experienced to take responsibilities and create learning environment to interact and facilitate the learning with competencies required for the functioning within the scope of nursing practice.

Purpose


 The purpose of this course is to produce knowledgeable competent nurses and midwives with clear critical thinking skills who can make independent decision in nursing situations within the scope of practices and motivated to respond to the changing needs of profession, health care delivery system and society with proper assertiveness and caring attitude. They are also prepared to assume the role of practitioner, teacher, supervisor, manager, researcher and administrator in all health care settings.

Terms and Conditions for Admission:

- The minimum age for admission is 17 years as on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission is 35 years.
- 2. Minimum Educational Qualification
- a) Candidate with Science who has passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in together and passed in English individually.
- b) Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
- c). Candidate shall be medically fit.
- d). Married candidates are also eligible for admission.

Admission Process

Selection of candidate is based on entrance examination (CET) conducted by Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, Lucknow (UP) annually followed by counseling.

INTRODUCTION:

ANM stands for Auxiliary Nurse Midwife. Unlike other nursing course, the ANM course is a widely recognized programme. ANM plays vital role in the rural health care delivery system. They are the active link between the community and the Health care system. The programme fits into the general educational pattern as well as nursing education system.

PURPOSE:

This course is to prepare an ANM to be trained in community health skills to practice basis health care in accordance with local condition and to meet the local health needs of the community.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION:

- The minimum age for admission is 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- The maximum age for admission is 35 years.
- 12 years of schooling (10+2 year course) recognized by CBSE/ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.
- Student shall be medically fit.
